AFFORDABLE CARE ACT AND CONFEDERATE FLAG

Results are based on telephone interviews with a random sample of ~2,013– national adults, aged 18+, living in all 50 states and the District of Columbia, conducted July 1-3 and 5, 2015. For results based on the total sample of National Adults, the margin of error is ± 3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

Interviews are conducted with respondents on landline telephones and cellular phones, with interviews conducted in Spanish for respondents who are primarily Spanish-speaking. Each sample of national adults includes a minimum quota of 50% cell phone respo
