Results are based on telephone interviews conduct December 7-11, 2016 with a random sample of £,0282 adults, aged 18+living in all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia For results based on the sample of national adults, the margin of sampling error is £4 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

Interviews are conducted with respondents on landline telephones and cellular phones, with interviews conducted in Spanish for respondents who are primarily Spanishpeaking. Each sample of national adults includes a minimum quota of 60% cell phone respondents and 0% landline respondents, with additional minimum quotas by region. Landlineand cell phone telephone numbers re selected using random digit dial methods. Gallup obtained sample for this study from Survey Sampling International Landline respondents are chosen at random within each household on the basis of which members the next birthday.

Samples are weighted to correct for unequal selection probability, noresponse, and/double coverage of landline and cell users in the two sampling frames. They are also weighted to match the national demographics of gender, age, race, Hispanic ethnicity, education, region, population density, and phone status (cell phone only/landline only/both and cell phone mostly). Demographic weighting targets are based on the March 201 Current Population Survey figures for the aged 18 and older U.S. population. Phone status targets are based on the July-December2015 National Health Interview Survey. Population density targets are based on the 2010 census. All reported margins of sampling error include the computed design effects for weighting.
