Results are based on telephone interviews conduct bruary 3-18, 2021 with a random sample of 1,021 adults, ages 18+, living in all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia For results based on the sample of national adults, the margin of sampling error is ±4 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

Interviews are conducted with respondents on landline telephones and cellular phones, with interviews conducted in Spanish for respondents whore primarily Spanish-speaking. Each sample of national adults includes a minimum quota of 70% cell phone respondents an 30% landline respondents, with additional minimum quotas by time zone within region. Landline and cell phone telephone numbers are seted using random digit dial methods. Gallup obtained sample for this study from Dynata. Landline respondents are chosen at random within each household on the basis of which membershae next birthday.

Samples are weighted to correct for unequal selection probability, neresponse, and double coverage of landline and cell users in the two ampling frames. They are also weighted to match the national demographics of gender, age, race, Hispanic ethnicity, education, region, population density, and phone status (cell phone only/landline only/both and cell phone mostly). Demographic weighting argets are based on the March 2091 Current Population Survey figures for the aged 18 and older U.S. population. Phone status targets are based on the July-December 2019 National Health Interview Survey. Population density targets are based on the 2010 census. All reported margins of sampling error include the computed design effects for weighting.
