Results are based on telephone interviews conducted October 2-23, 2023, with a random sample of 1,009 adults, ages 18+, living in all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia. For results based on this sample of national adults, the margin of sampling error is  $\pm 4$  percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of -- 498 -- national adults in Form A and the sample of 511-- national adults in Form B, the margin of sampling error is  $\pm 5$  percentage points.

For results based on the sample of 478 U.S. adults with a gun in their household, the margin of sampling error is  $\pm 5$  percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

Interviews are conducted with respondents on landline telephones and cellular phones, with interviews conducted in Spanish for respondents who are primarily Spanish-speaking. Each sample of national adults includes a minimum quota of 80% cell phone respondents and 20% landline respondents, with additional minimum quotas by time zone within region.
